Dear Parents, Guardians and Staff of Southington High School,

The administration would like to notify you that radon testing will be conducted at Southington High School between January 8th and 11th, 2018. According to Connecticut General Statute Sec. 10-220(d), all public schools must have radon levels re-evaluated every five years. The purpose of the five-year re-evaluation of radon levels is to determine if radon levels have changed in the past five years.

EnviroMed Services, Inc. will conduct the five-year radon re-evaluation of the school building. Small test devices containing charcoal will be placed in 10% of the student or staff occupied rooms that are in contact with the ground. Radon test devices are safe and do not cause any adverse health effects. These devices will be left in place for two to three school days.

The school administration will keep radon test reports on file for review when all testing has been completed. If elevated levels of radon are found, steps will be taken to reduce radon levels below the United States Environmental Protection Agency action level of 4.0 pCi/L.
