What To Bring: A **Birth Certificate** with a *raised seal* must be presented at the time of registration for **ALL players**. Parent or legal guardian must present **three** forms of **proof of address** (a valid Government issued photo ID card, a federal/state/local tax bill and a utility bill showing your address).

Fees (2 player max): Challengers (all ages)	\$35.00 per Child
Players 5 to 7 years old	\$90.00 per Child
Players 8 to 9 years old	\$125.00 per Child
Players 10 to 12 years old	\$140.00 per Child
Players 13 to 16 years old	\$150.00 per Child

****Player must be registered and payment received by February 11, 2017 to receive early bird pricing. Prices increase by \$5 after February 11. If payment is not received in full by the start of the season, your child(ren) may not be able to participate until payment is received due to insurance and liability reasons.****

Divisions	Ages	Description
T-Ball	4-6	10 game season. A basic introduction to baseball.
Farm**	6-8	15 game season. Intended for players who are league age 6 through 8. Players play 10 positions including catcher and four outfielders. Coach pitch and player pitch utilized. Games consist of 3-out innings with some limitations. Bunting and stealing introduced. Two games and one or two practices every week during the season.
Minors**	8-11	15 game season including playoffs. Intended for players league age 8 through 11. A 12-year old can play with a waiver from Little League. Players league age 8 and 9 who wish to play in Minors must participate in evaluations. Games will be played under Little League rules with a few limitations. Two games and one or two practices every week during the season.
Majors	9-12	18 game season followed by playoffs and town championship. Intended for players league age 9 through 12. Games will be played under Little League rules. One or two games and up to 3 practices every week during the season.
Junior League	13-15	Ages 13, 14, 15 who are not on a high school team. Ages 13 and 14 can make the All Star Team. Season begins early April and runs through early June.
Senior League	15-16	Ages 15 and 16. Season begins after June 7
Challengers	5-18*	Enables children with mental and/or physical challenges to enjoy the game of baseball. Challenger Division is for ages 5 - 18 or still attending High School (up to age 22).

**Divisions are subject to change depending on number of participants.

All children ages 4 and above as of December 31, 2017 are eligible to register.
