Grade 10 Course Selection Worksheet

Parents and students are asked to complete course selection online on PowerSchool from **February 4 through February 11**. Use this worksheet to help you determine the courses that you will select. The Program of Studies is available on the SHS website. If you do not have computer access, the School Counseling Office can provide a paper copy of our Program of Studies. If you do not have computer access to complete the process, your counselor will see teacher recommended courses online and meet with you to enter your elective choices.

Many required courses need a teacher recommendation. When you enter the Class Registration screen on PowerSchool, you will see courses that your teacher has recommended. If you have questions about level recommendations, discuss them with your teacher. Parents and students may contact teachers through e-mail. If you choose to take a course at a level other than that recommended by the teacher, there is a form available on the SHS School Counseling Dept. website. Teachers may recommend other courses that are not required; you may select these if you choose to do so.

Complete the online selection process by clicking on the Class Registration icon at the side of the parent portal page. More detailed information about this process is available on the SHS Website.

To make course selections:

- (1) click on the Class Registration icon at the side of the parent portal page of PowerSchool.
- (2) click on the pencil next to each subject area, including the courses that have been recommended
- (3) click in the box at the front of the course(s) that you want to take
- (4) click okay at the bottom of this pop-up screen

NOTE: There may be more than one page of available courses for each subject area. This is indicated by page numbers at the bottom of the course list. You should see everything on this sheet in PowerSchool.

After you have made all of your course selections, click Submit at the bottom of this screen.

Students should select a minimum of 6.5 credits, although many students will select more than 6.5 credits.
