- Practice for the SAT on Khan Academy! <https://www.khanacademy.org/> Link to your PSAT results if you haven’t already done so through Google Classroom (code xj4rjgg) for personalized study.
- SAT school day is April 9th. Register for an additional SAT in the Spring or Fall of Senior year on www.collegeboard.org and/or the ACT on www.act.org
- Fee waivers are available for free and reduced lunch eligible students. Please ask your counselor!
- Make sure to write down your College Board username and password & hold onto it for next year...you will need it! CEEB Code for SHS 070-690.
- Sign up for SAT subject tests if your college(s) require them.
- Start visiting colleges THIS SPRING! Many schools will offer open houses...this is a great time to visit!
- The Common Application is available beginning August 1st- <https://apply.commonapp.org/login> Most 4-year colleges in CT as well as over 700 schools nationwide will accept the Common Application.
- Consider asking a junior year teacher(s) for a college letter of recommendation before you leave for summer. Provide them with any materials they request, such as a senior brag sheet.
- Remember to stay organized, continue to keep up the great work, and get ready for senior year...it will be here before you know it! Colleges do want to see you continue with a strong course load as senior.
