Dear Parent/Guardian and Student:

The Board of Education is pleased to announce summer enrichment courses for high school students. Now in its fourth year, the enrichment program is providing valuable opportunities for students to build skills that prepare students for post-secondary education.

Summer Enrichment Program

- Enrichment courses will be offered based on a minimum enrollment per class.
- Courses are open to high school students.
- Students who register first will be given preference on a first come/first served basis.
- A full refund will be granted should the course be closed due to minimum/maximum enrollment.
- Tuition is non-refundable after the second day of the program.

***First class:** On the first day of class only, there will be a general meeting in the Southington High School cafeteria prior to the start of each session whereby students will be assigned to teachers and rooms.

A Summer of Preparation

SAT –Writing & Verbal

Students planning to take the SAT in the fall

Instructor: Mrs. Reilly

As the student works through the course, he or she will focus on learning more about his or her strengths and weaknesses as well as learn test-taking strategies that are specific to the SAT. At the start of the course the student, with teacher guidance, will identify individual weaknesses in the areas of reading comprehension and writing skills. Essay writing, specifically for the SAT, will also be a focus. Students will learn strategies for the essay in regards to timing and style. The instructor will then provide personalized instruction and develop a growth plan for each student. In doing so, students will develop the necessary skills in order to be well prepared to take the SAT.

Session I or II*

July 2 – July 26 (18 days)

Enrollment: 8-14 Students

Enrollment Fee: \$225

Fee includes a copy of an SAT Study Guide book (2018 Edition)

SAT –Math

Students planning to take the SAT in the fall

Instructor: Mr. Hinman

As the student works through the course, he or she will focus on learning more about his or her strengths and in all domains specific to the mathematics portion of the SAT. At the start of the course the student will be able to identify individual weaknesses in the areas of algebra, geometry, data analysis and problem solving. The instructor will then provide personalized instruction and develop a growth plan for each student. In doing so, students will develop the necessary skills in order to be well prepared to take the SAT and develop test-taking strategies.

Session I or II*

July 2 – July 26 (18 days)

Enrollment: 8-14 Students

Enrollment Fee: \$225

Fee includes a copy of an SAT Study Guide book (2018 Edition)

*A second SAT session will open should enrollment exceed 14 students. These courses will still be offered in either session I or II only.

Creative Writing Workshop

Instructor: Mrs. Caouette

In the creative writing workshop writers will explore poetry, memoir, and fiction through their own writing and the writing of published authors. The focus will be on the study of author's craft and peer feedback as tools to improve writing. Students will also analyze written texts, participate in workshops, and, if interested, explore opportunities for publication.

Session III only

July 9 – July 13 (5 days)

Minimum Enrollment: 8 Students

Enrollment Fee: \$60

Introduction to Computer Programming

Instructor: Mr. Courtemanche

This course is intended for students interested in gaining foundational skills in computer programming. Using Scratch, students will learn how to design, write, and run simple programs. Core concepts will include manipulating objects, handling events, and conditional (If-Then) statements. Amongst the many programs students will create, by the end of this course, students will have made their own game and an animated movie scene.

Session III only

July 2 – July 20 (14 days)

Minimum Enrollment: 8 Students

Enrollment Fee: \$160

Preparing Your College Essay & Resume

Instructor: Mrs. Reilly

This course is strictly for students entering their senior year the Fall of 2018. The focus of the course will be giving students individualized help for those beginning their college application process. Specialized attention will be given to choosing, writing, and workshopping students' college essays. In addition, help will be given if needed for supplemental or scholarship essays. Students will also be given guidance on how to create an attractive resume for college.

Session III only 12:30 – 2:00 p.m.**

July 16 – July 24 (7 days)

Enrollment: 6 Students

Enrollment Fee: \$75

**A second session will be offered if enrollment exceeds 10 students and will start July 5th and conclude July 13th, session times remain the same.
