The Board of Education is pleased to announce online summer enrichment courses for high school students. The enrichment program is providing opportunities for students to build skills that prepare students for post-secondary education and for developing life valuable life skills.

**Summer Enrichment Program**

- Enrichment courses will be offered based on a minimum enrollment per class.
- Courses are open to high school students.
- Students who register first will be given preference on a first come/first served basis.
- A full refund will be granted should the course be closed due to minimum/maximum enrollment.
- Tuition is non-refundable after the second day of the program.
- Students must provide a current email for logging into daily lessons

**\*First online class: Monday, July 6th, 2020. Prior to the start of the program, your child will receive a link or code that will be used to enter the teacher’s online course. It is therefore important to check your emails prior to the first day.**

# A Summer of Opportunity

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## ***SAT –Writing & Verbal***

*Session II only*

**Students planning to take the SAT in the fall**

**Instructor: Mrs. Reilly**

As the student works through the course, he or she will focus on learning more about his or her strengths and weaknesses as well as learn test-taking strategies that are specific to the SAT. At the start of the course student's test taking weaknesses will be identified, as well as student weaknesses in both reading and writing. Test taking strategies will be balanced with individualized instruction based on weaknesses.

Students will develop the necessary skills in order to be well prepared to take the SAT, while honing reading and writing skills essential to the everyday English classroom. Students will meet virtually, through Google Meets, two hours, every weekday, for eighteen days. These sessions will always include a group lesson on the topic for the day. They may also include small group and individualized instruction via Google Meets.

***Fee includes a year-long license to Preparing for the New SAT; Evidence Based Reading and Writing.***

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## ***SAT –Math***

*Session I*

**Students planning to take the SAT in the fall**

**Instructor: Mr. Hinman**

As the student works through the course, he or she will focus on learning more about his or her strengths and weaknesses in all domains specific to the mathematics portion of the SAT. At the start of the course the student will be able to identify individual weaknesses in the areas of algebra, geometry, data analysis and problem solving, and immediately begin working through challenging problem sets to develop their capacity in these areas. The instructor will then provide personalized instruction and develop a growth plan for each student. In the online setting students will be expected to attend regularly scheduled, small-group meetings with the instructor as well as complete independent practice assignments utilizing the Khan Academy online platform in addition to a number of other viable resources. In doing so, students will develop the necessary skills in order to be well prepared to take the SAT and develop a strong arsenal of test-taking strategies.

***July 8th – 29th (18 days)***

***Enrollment:*** 8-16 Students

***Enrollment Fee:*** \$240

***Fee includes a copy of an SAT Study Guide book (2020 Edition)***

**Instructor: Mrs. Reilly**

This 5-day course is strictly for students entering their senior year in the Fall of 2020. The focus of the course will be giving students individualized help beginning their college application process. Each day there will be a virtual class with a teacher directed lesson covering one step in the process of applying to college. After the daily virtual lesson, students will work directly with the teacher to begin their applications, but with a specialized focus on choosing, writing, and workshopping students' college essays. During the time of the class, students will create an attractive resume for college, and begin the process of requesting a letter of recommendation. They will also begin the gathering of information needed to begin filling out college applications. Virtual sessions, through Google Docs, will be two hours a day for five total days. This time will be broken into two segments: meeting as a small group and meeting individually with the instructor.
